






## Álvaro Siza

Matosinhos, 25 June 1933

Born in 1933 a few kilometers from Porto, Álvaro Siza graduated in architecture in 1955 at the University of Porto. He stands as one of the leading exponents of Portuguese architecture. Álvaro Siza received the Pritzker Architecture Prize in 1992, and the Royal Gold Medal for Architecture from the British RIBA in 2009. He also was awarded the Golden Lion for Lifetime Achievement at the 12th International Architecture Exhibition of the Venice Biennale in 2012.

Inspired by a journey Álvaro Siza took to East Timor, a former Portuguese colony in East Asia known as Timor Loro Sae, Lorosae denotes the place where the sun rises. Through the translucent glass in different pure and brilliant finishes, Lorosae Table lamp is a rechargeable, battery-powered design that spreads a diffused light and embodies a direct connection to Timor Loro Sae's culture and geographical identity.

Grâce à son verre translucide aux différentes finitions pures et brillantes, Lorosae Table est un design rechargeable, alimenté grâce à une batterie, qui émet une lumière diffuse et exprime un lien direct avec la culture et l'identité géographique de Timor Loro Sae.

DE Inspiriert von einer Reise des Architekten Álvaro Siza nach Osttimor, der ehemaligen portugiesischen Kolonie in Ostasien, bekannt als Timor Loro Sae, bezeichnet „Lorosae“ den Ort, an dem die Sonne aufgeht. Durch transluzentes Glas in verschiedenen reinen und glänzenden Ausführungen strahlt Lorosae Table ein sanftes, diffuses Licht aus. Das wiederaufladbare, batteriebetriebene Lichtobjekt verkörpert eine direkte Verbindung zur Kultur und geografischen Identität von Timor Loro Sae.
